Expressive Drawing with Belinda Evans

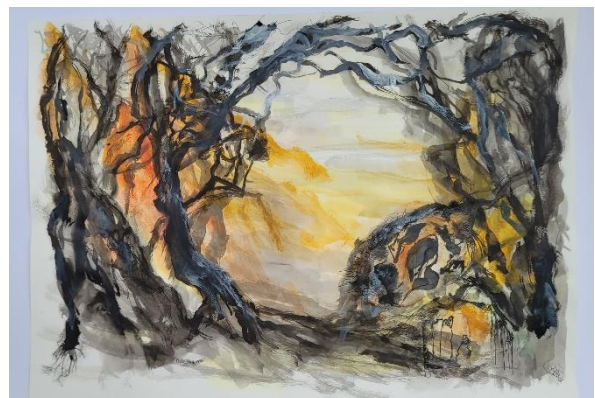

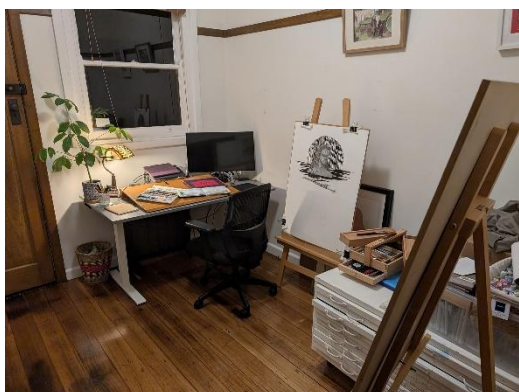
